

SUMMARY PROPOSED CHANGES TO
ROCHESTER WOODCARVERS CONSTITUTION AND BYLAWS
PRESENTED TO MEMBERS October 19, 2013

The Executive Board of the Rochester Woodcarvers received in writing proposed changes to the constitution and bylaws. The board reviewed the proposed changes and recommends approval by the membership.

CHANGES:

1. The changes only effect the term of office for President and Vice President.
2. President would serve as president for 1 year (currently 2 years).
3. Vice President normally succeeds to president next year thus serving 2 years on the board, if elected the first year of his/her term. If VP second year of term could serve a total of 3 years.
4. Executive board membership, consisting of 7 members, would agree to serve for 2 years.
5. Secretary and Treasurer would normally be officers both years of their 2 year term.

The Constitution and Bylaws, showing additions and deletions, if the changes were approved, will be posted on the web site for your review. They will also be available at the next two meetings and in the minutes of the Executive Board meetings.

These changes will be presented at two meetings prior to voting at the third meeting.
