

The Carver and Turner Circus

A bit of history about the circus.

"In the early days of the Carvers and Turners circus, Lena Overoski, gave birth to Siamese twins. After a brief affair, Lena had been abandoned by the father, Omar Spragge, who had been traveling with a band of Hungarian Gypsies.



Fortunately, Lena, who was the bearded lady in the circus, had a close relationship with Hans Schicklegruber, the sword swallower. Hans was able to separate the twins and allow them to lead a nearly normal existence. Stub and Stretch chose the circus life, which had been the bastion of the Overoski family for decades.

Stub, who attended the Wharton School of Circus Finance, handled the ticket sales, and Stretch attended the prestigious, Slick's Auctioneering School, specializing in promotional items. The boys, along with their mother Lena, were able to promote the circus as "The Greatest Show on Earth", which is currently performing at The Festival of Trees."
